12 within 20 days after the service of this summons, excluding the day of service, or within
13 60 days after the service of this summons if served outside the State of Washington, or a
14 default judgment may be entered against you without notice. A default judgment is one
where Plaintiffs are entitled to what they ask for because you have not responded. If you
serve a notice of appearance on the undersigned attorney, you are entitled to notice before
a default judgment may be entered.

15 You may demand that the Plaintiffs file this lawsuit with the court. If you do so,
16 the demand must be in writing and must be served upon the person signing this summons.
17 Within 14 days after you serve the demand, the plaintiffs must file this lawsuit with the
court, or the service on you of this summons and complaint will be void.

18 If you wish to seek the advice of an attorney in this matter, you should do so
19 promptly so that your written response, if any, may be served on time.
